ORDER AFFECTING PARENT/GUARDIANS

- 1. Immediately after this court hearing, meet with the juvenile probation officer to discuss your child's terms of probation.
- 2. Provide transportation to the appropriate law enforcement agency for purposes of initial and annual sex offender registration.
- 3. Provide transportation for the child to each counseling session, polygraph examination and/or mandated programs.
- 4. Attend counseling with/without the child as deemed necessary by the treatment provider.
- 5. Do not remove the child, or permit the child to be removed from ______, County, Texas without an approved travel permit.
- 6. Do not add people to the household without prior notice to the child's juvenile probation officer.
- 7. Report any missed appointments or any probation violations to the child's juvenile probation officer no later than the next business day.
- 8. Do not allow the child to have contact with any child under age ______ or any child who is physically or mentally challenged, including any member of your household, unless supervised by a responsible adult who is aware of the child's offense.
- 9. Do not allow your child to purchase, possess, access or view sexually oriented visual or audio material. So not allow your child to go on the premises where such material is available. Do not allow your child to access any electronically transmitted sexually oriented material by phone or computer.
- 10. Install and activate, at your own cost, software capable of blocking access to sexually explicit material on any personal computer in your residence. Permit access by the juvenile probation officer at any time to any personal computer in your residence to monitor compliance with the above.

- 11. Pay the costs of any medical, psychological or other evaluation/counseling/treatment incurred by the victim(s).
- 12. Return for a hearing regarding review of Sex Offender treatment on the _____ day of _____, 20___, and _____.
