**NEW PROCEDURES FOR  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION URINE COLLECTIONS**

Effective **August 25, 2008**, your collection site must comply with the following changes to the Department of Transportation's drug testing regulations:

1. All **return to duty and follow up** drug tests must now be observed.
2. The **observer** in an observed urine collection must request the employee to raise his or her shirt, blouse, or dress/skirt, as appropriate, above the waist and lower clothing and underpants to show you, by turning around, that they do not have a prosthetic device. After you have determined that the employee does not have such a device, you may permit the employee to return clothing to its proper position for observed urination.
3. An employee will be deemed to have **refused** a drug test if he or she:
  - a. Fails to follow the observer's instructions to raise his/her clothing above the waist, lower clothing and underpants, and turn around to permit the observer to determine if he or she has any type of prosthetic or other device that could be used to interfere with the collection process; or
  - b. Possesses or wears a prosthetic or other device that could be used to interfere with the collection process.

CHAPTER 141. DRUGS CONTROLLED BY SUBSTANCE ABUSE  
SUBCHAPTER D. OFFENSES AND PENALTIES**

**ART. 481.133. Offense: Fabrication of Drug Test Results**

(a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or recklessly causes or procures, with intent to falsify any substance or drug test result or to falsify drug test results.

(b) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or recklessly delivers, knowingly permits to deliver, or intentionally delivers, to another person a substance or drug test result that the person knows or believes to be false or that the person knows or believes to be falsified.

(c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or recklessly delivers, knowingly permits to deliver, or intentionally delivers, to another person a substance or drug test result that the person knows or believes to be false or that the person knows or believes to be falsified.

(d) An offense under this article may be a Class A misdemeanor or a Class B misdemeanor.

Dear Bruce:

Today in the Federal Register, the DEA issued a notice of intent to temporarily place five synthetic cannabinoids into the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) pursuant to the temporary scheduling provisions under 21 U.S.C. 811(b) of the CSA.

The substances are 1-pentyl-3-(1-naphthyl)indole (JWH-018), 1-butyl-3-(1-naphthyl)indole (JWH-073), 1-[2-(4-methylphenyl)-3-(1-naphthyl)indol-1-yl]propan-1-one (JWH-250), 9-(1,1-dimethylpyrrolid-2-yl)-1-(1R,3R)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl-phenol (CP-47,497), and 3-(1,1-dimethylpyrrolid-2-yl)-1-(1R,3R)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl-phenol (CP-47,497 CB homologue).

This intended action is based on a finding by the DEA Deputy Administrator that the placement of these synthetic cannabinoids into Schedule I of the CSA is necessary to avoid an imminent hazard to the public safety. Finalization of this action will impose criminal sanctions and regulatory controls of Schedule I substances under the CSA on the manufacture, distribution, possession, importation, and exportation of these synthetic cannabinoids.
