

## Retributive and Restorative Justice Which approach are you balancing? Retribution Restorative **Puritans** Quakers Eye for an Eye Direct Accountability to Retribution is justified victim and Community by the juvenile's guilt Recognizes Placement severs relationship with relationship to community community The Bell Curve!! The statistical significance or insignificance of going "outside the box"

#### **Creative Dispositions**

- A balanced order that considers the four core issues in providing the best opportunity for successful completion of the term of probation
- Allows the flexibility within the core issues to be utilized.
- There is no magic pill to cure adolescence

#### **Creative Disposition Examples**

- The goals are to teach
- 1. Empathy
- 2. Tolerance
- Other examples...

#### Creative Placements

- Meets the core requirements in a safer environment that, with time, allows the juvenile to amend their behavior OR move past the stage they were in at the time of arrest.
- Rites of Passage
- Glen Mills
- Youth Center of the High Plains
