# TYPES OF OFFENSES

Probation TFC §§54.04; 54.0451; HRC §245.151

- Conduct Indicating a Need for Supervision
  - Non-traffic fine-only; Runaway; Huffing; School violation that results in expulsion; Sexting; Prostitution
- Status Offenses
  - Would not be a violation if committed by adult (e.g. runaway, MIP, curfew)
- Delinquent Conduct
  - Jailable misdemeanors and felonies
